COMMISSIONER'S SUNBEAM REVIEW COMMITTEE GUIDELINES

The Commissioner's Sunbeam Award is given on behalf of the Commissioner, who is the Territorial Leader of The Salvation Army. It is the highest award a girl may achieve in the Sunbeam Program. The award consists of letters of commendation, a certificate from Territorial Headquarters and a medal to be pinned on the sunbeam sash.

To qualify for this award a sunbeam must:

- Ø Be at least 8 years old or in the third grade
- Ø Be an active sunbeam, in good standing for at least one year
- Ø Be recommended by her leader and corps officer
- Ø Attend Sunday school or worship services regularly
- Ø Complete the required emblems
- Ø Participate in a Commissioner's Sunbeam Award Review

COMMISSIONER'S SUNBEAM AWARD REVIEW GUIDELINES FOR SUNBEAM LEADERS

The Commissioner's Sunbeam Award is given on behalf of the Commissioner, who is the Territorial Leader of The Salvation Army. It is the highest award a girl may achieve in the Sunbeam Program. This information is provided to help you as you prepare the sunbeam for the review committee. The review committee will be looking for the following:

1. Evidence of knowledge in each of the 13 required emblems.
2. Sharing of materials such as photographs, logos, charts, or art projects for at least 3 activities.

Membership:

The sunbeam will be asked to recite the Sunbeam pledge, declaration, and motto, demonstrate the Sunbeam salute, and share with the review committee when the sauté is used. The committee members may ask the sunbeam what the pledge, declaration and motto means to her.

Second Class:

The sunbeam should show the proper way to wear her Sunbeam uniform, show a scrapbook of her troop activities and talk about some of the special events in which her troop has participated.

First Cass:

The sunbeam should be prepared to tell what she has learned about the American Flag and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Since each of the remaining emblems has optional activities, the sunbeam will only be required to have knowledge of the emblem requirements that she has completed. Review only those requirements.
